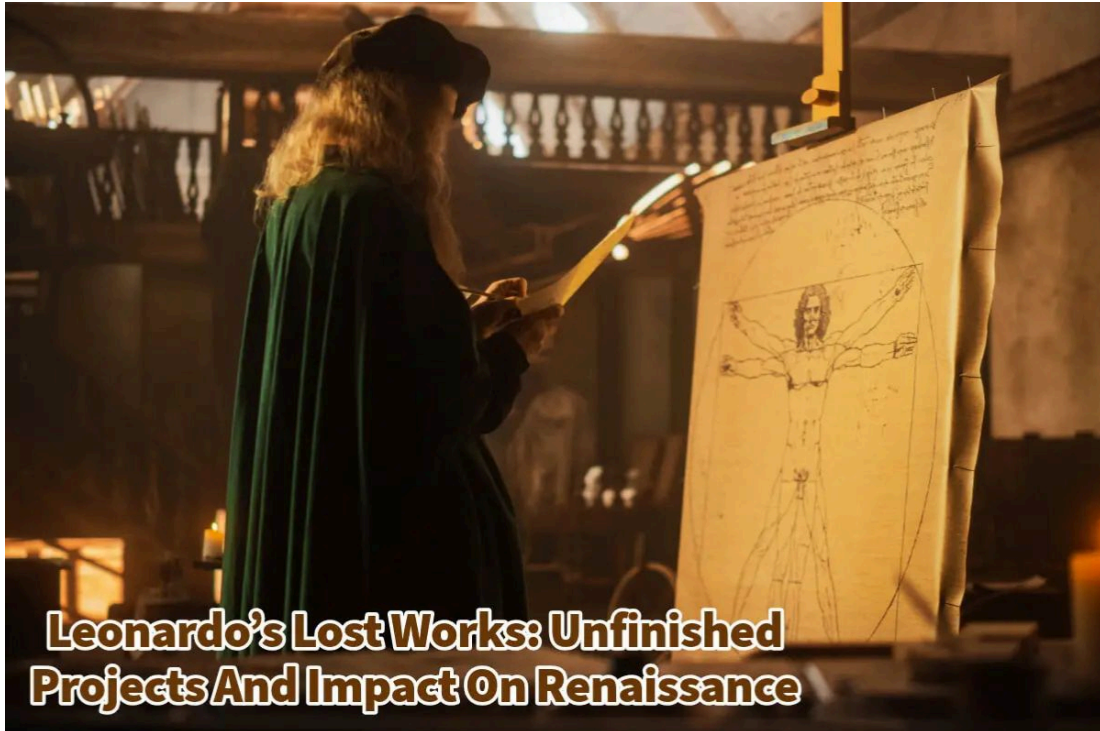

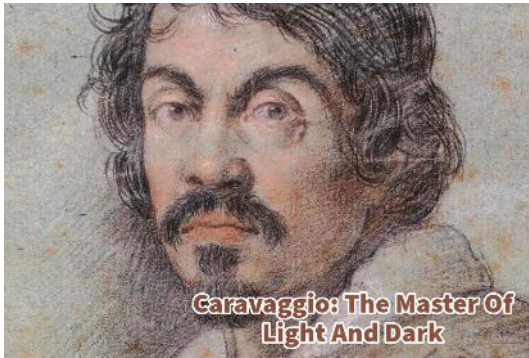

The Enchantment Of Hawaiian Quilts

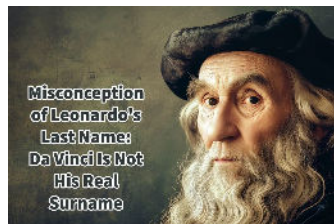

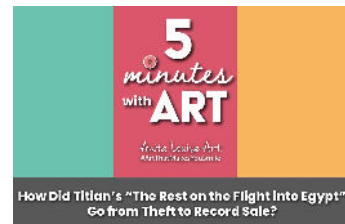
